NILGIRI BOREHOLE PROJECT UPDATE | RESTORING WATER, RESTORING HOPE WITH MANCOSA

This month, weFEEDsa, in partnership with **Mancosa**, installed a borehole system at **Nilgiri Secondary School**, addressing critical water shortages. Originally designed for 600 learners, the school now serves over 2,300, placing immense strain on existing infrastructure. The addition of the borehole and two JoJo tanks ensure reliable water access, supporting attendance and learning. With only water testing remaining, this initiative restores dignity and stability—demonstrating that when water flows, education thrives. We thank **Mancosa** for their generous support and look forward to more corporates joining in to uplift and invest in schools within their communities.



A KNOCKOUT MOMENT FOR JOSE "JK" KADIMA
